

FAQs

WHAT IS THE ENTRY PROCEDURE?

To apply for Breakthrough Brits 2018, please submit a completed online application form, along with your CV, showreel and any required supporting materials by 5pm on Monday 28 May 2018. Please note all applications must have been started by 5pm on Monday 21 May 2018.

WHO CAN ENTER?

Anyone who is British; will be over the age of 18 on November 1 2018; and is a current resident of the United Kingdom may apply. We ask that you be available for the Breakthrough Brits reception being held in central London in Autumn 2018.

WHAT ARE THE ENTRY CRITERIA?

In film and TV, we are looking for candidates who:

- Are making a name for themselves as a performer or in a craft specialism within the film and/or television industry.
- Have a professional credit on a piece of work that has been, or will be:
 - theatrically released in the UK;
 - broadcast on a UK television channel;
 - commissioned and broadcast by an online broadcaster

between August 2017 and August 2018, or is reasonably expected to at time of application.

- If writers, producers, performers or directors working in scripted, have, at the time of application, completed at least one, but no more than two, projects on which they had a lead role.
- If producers and directors working in factual and non-scripted (this includes producer/directors, series producers, multi-camera and gallery directors and development producers) have, at the time of application, completed at least one project on which they had a lead or impactful role.
- If from any other craft area (in factual or non-scripted in any role), have, at the time of application, completed at least one project on which they had a lead or impactful role.

In games, we are looking for candidates who:

- Are making a name for themselves in their field within the games industry.
- Have a professional credit on a piece of work that has been, or will be, published or released in the UK between August 2017 and August 2018, or is reasonably expected to at the time of application.

- Have completed, at the time of application, at least one project on which they had a lead or impactful role.

I AM BRITISH BUT I LIVE ABROAD, CAN I ENTER?

We ask that applicants to Breakthrough Brits are currently resident in the UK.

IS THERE AN UPPER OR LOWER AGE LIMIT?

As stipulated, the Initiative is open to candidates aged 18 or over on November 1 2018. Younger candidates will be considered in exceptional circumstances. There is no upper age limit.

DO I HAVE TO PAY?

It is free to apply, be considered and take part in the Breakthrough Brits initiative!

WHAT DO YOU MEAN BY 'IMPACTFUL ROLE'?

We recognise the team nature of working in craft and technical areas of games, film and television, and are looking for those individuals who have taken a leading role within a team that has had a significant impact on the outcome of the project. This may not necessarily be the most senior or leading member of the team but someone who has been integral to the project and who has impressed their colleagues with their talent and passion.

In 2018, we are also accepting applications from directors and producers working in factual and non-scripted who have had a lead or impactful role.

The criteria for writers, directors, producers and actors working in fiction and scripted are still required to have had at least one but no more than two lead roles at the time of application.

WHAT DO YOU MEAN BY THEATRICAL RELEASE?

As with BAFTA's Film Awards, films must be exhibited publicly to a paying audience on at least ten commercial screens in the UK for at least seven days in aggregate (not including festival screenings).

WHAT ABOUT SHORT FILMS?

We expect applicants to Breakthrough Brit to be working in feature films. Short films will be considered as part of your body of work to date.

I WORK IN UX IN GAMES. CAN I APPLY?

We accept applications from candidates works in UX and UI roles in games.

I WORK IN A TEAM; HOW DO WE APPLY TOGETHER?

We welcome applications from teams (maximum of 3 people only) who truly feel they have had their breakthrough together. If you would like to apply as a team, please ask all members of your team to submit their own separate application forms; this is so we have all the personal information we need.

The answers to 'What makes you a Breakthrough Brit?' and 'How would you benefit from the Breakthrough Brits Programme' may be the same across all team members.

Once all members have all submitted, we will link up the applications our end to ensure they are considered together.

I AM AN AGENT WISHING TO APPLY ON MY CLIENT'S BEHALF; IS THIS POSSIBLE?

We ask that all candidates to Breakthrough Brits answer the key application questions themselves and use their own details on the site. Agents may however administer the application on their client's behalf.

WHAT DO YOU WANT FROM MY SHOWREEL?

Showreels should showcase your work and experience to date. They should include material from your lead or head of department role. All work should be clearly labelled on screen.

HOW LONG CAN MY SHOWREEL BE?

Total running time for showreels may be up to 5 minutes. Longer showreels will be accepted but the Jury may choose to watch only 5 minutes of your showreel.

I'M A WRITER; DO I NEED TO SUBMIT A SHOWREEL?

As a writer for the screen, we do need to see examples of your work as it appears thereon. Writers are also asked to submit a script extract of no more than 10 pages for Jury review.

I WORK IN GAMES; DO I NEED TO SUBMIT A SHOWREEL?

We recognise that individuals working in certain disciplines, such as games, do not routinely have traditional showreels so we also accept:

- Trailers
- Gameplay videos
- Vlogs of you discussing your work

Showreels are used to give the Jury a sense of your work to date; they do not have to be flashy!

WHAT HAPPENS IF I EXPERIENCE TECHNICAL PROBLEMS WHEN UPLOADING?

WHEN DO APPLICATIONS OPEN?

Entry opens on Monday 19 March 2018 at 12pm.

WHEN DO APPLICATIONS CLOSE?

The deadline to submit an application is Monday 28 May 2018 at 5pm.

I WORK IN THE INDUSTRY. HOW DO I RECOMMEND SOMEONE ELSE?

Breakthrough Brits is an open call out for talented individuals working across film, games and television. All candidates must fully complete the application form in order to be considered for the initiative.

We do not check the eligibility of recommended candidates; it is their responsibility to review the application information and make the decision to apply.

If you would like to suggest someone as a Breakthrough Brit please contact breakthrough@bafta.org with their name and, if possible, contact details and we will invite them to apply.

A recommendation, or lack thereof, will not be considered as part of the judging process and candidates who are suggested by their peers, but then fail to submit a fully completed application form by the deadline will not be eligible for consideration.

I HAVE BEEN INDUSTRY RECOMMENDED AS A POTENTIAL CANDIDATE. DO BAFTA CHECK THE ELIGIBILITY OF RECOMMENDED CANDIDATES BEFORE INVITING THEM TO APPLY?

We do not check the eligibility of recommended candidates. All such candidates are informed that an industry professional has recommended them and are invited to apply directly by BAFTA. It is then the responsibility of each candidate to read all the information provided thoroughly, check their eligibility and choose to apply if they are interested in the opportunity and feel they meet the requirements.

I DO NOT WORK IN THE INDUSTRY BUT I WOULD LIKE TO RECOMMEND A BREAKTHROUGH BRIT. CAN I?

Yes! We welcome recommendations from members of the public. To recommend a Breakthrough Brit please email their name and role to breakthrough@bafta.org.

WHEN WILL I KNOW IF I HAVE BEEN SELECTED?

BAFTA will contact you the w/c 24 September 2018 if you have been selected as a Breakthrough Brit. The successful Breakthrough Brits will be announced in Autumn 2018.

WHAT IS THE COMMITMENT REQUIRED FROM ME?

By entering the Initiative you declare that you are able to attend the Breakthrough Brits announcement event and will take part in any subsequent events and mentoring sessions if

you are selected until November 2018. You also agree to be named in the media and to participate in promotional and press activities before, during and after the event, including:

1. Media interviews
2. Photo opportunities
