THE COURSE

Once a working vineyard, the Oakmont Country Club opened to great fanfare in 1922. Max Behr designed the golf course to capture the character of the Arroyo Verdugo landscape. A devastating fire destroyed the original Tudor clubhouse in 1946, but not the spirit of its members who rebuilt the clubhouse the following year. Oakmont has played host to a number of professional tournaments, notably the LPGA tournament in the 1980's through 1990's.

A complete clubhouse remodel was undertaken in 1995, resulting in the spacious, contemporary clubhouse enjoyed by members and their guests today.



Oakmont's 18-hole championship golf course is a classic Southern California style course featuring a challenging layout and undulating greens. Beautifully tree-lined and well bunkered, the course provides a tough, but fair test of skill for professionals and amateurs alike.




