Academy Screenings and Events Code

1. This Code applies to all Academy online events.
2. The Academy's events programme is designed to provide members with the best possible viewing experience for voting and educational purposes.
3. I agree to abide by the following rules (and I accept that these rules will also apply to guests viewing events with me):
 - 3.1 The use of recording equipment of any kind is strictly prohibited without prior authorisation from the Academy. Any recordings taken during an event cannot be published in any form without the authorisation of the Academy.
 - 3.2 Attendees must not harass or abuse Panellists, Attendees or BAFTA staff during the event and any such behaviour will result in your removal from the event and escalation to the appropriate authorities, according to the severity of the incident. All decisions on removal are final and rest with BAFTA Staff and event management.
4. Latecomers may not be admitted. Should capacity for the event be reached at the event start time, attendees may be unable to join and will be placed in a waiting room where entry will only be permitted should space become available

You may not use, copy, reproduce, republish, upload, post, transmit, distribute or modify any Trademarks in any way, including in advertising or publicity pertaining to or distribution of materials, without prior written consent.
