Terms and conditions:

The closing date for application is 23:59 on Tuesday 23rd of April 2024. The ballot will be drawn randomly after the application closing date. All successful applicants will be informed on or before Tuesday 30th of April 2024. Applicants can enter for themselves and one guest. Both names must be supplied at the point of application and can NOT be changed at any point after the application has been submitted. Please only submit one entry from for you OR you guest, we cannot accept more than one entry per pair. All attendees must be aged 12 years old and above on 12th of May 2024. Attendees under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Upon gaining a place through the ballot, details on where to collect wristbands from will be supplied to you and your guest. Access to the viewing areas are not permitted without a valid wristband. Wristbands will be issued on the day of the Awards at a central London (zone 1 or zone 2) location. Wristbands will only be issued once photographic ID has been shown along with the confirmation email. Please do not go to the venue without a ticket or wristband. Security will turn people away to prevent queues from forming. Overnight queuing will not be permitted so please do not attempt to queue on Saturday or early on Sunday.
